



ZAGREB CHILDREN FIS

REGULATIONS

1. TYPE OF COMPETITION

ZAGREB CHILDREN FIS is the international slalom and giant slalom for **CHILDREN** belonging to the National Federation. The *ZAGREB CHILDREN FIS* is organized by the Zagreb Ski Association.

2. CATEGORY

K1 - Children I year born 1997. and 1998.

K2 - Children II year born 1995. and 1996.

Children under 11 years old are not eligible.

3. DISCIPLINES

Slalom:	K1 - Children I	vertical drop max. 120 m, 30-35% of the vertical drop, +/- 3 direction changes
	K2 - Children II	vertical drop max. 160 m, 30-35% of the vertical drop, +/- 3 direction changes
Giantslalom:	K1 - Children I	vertical drop max. 250 m, 13-15% of the vertical drop,
	K2 - Children II	vertical drop max. 250 m, 13-15% of the vertical drop, 2 runs

4. THE RIGHT OF PARTICIPATION AND QUOTA REGULATIONS

All the FIS member countries have the right to take part in the competition. The quota per nation is max. 4 Children I (K1) and 6 Children II (K2) resulting in the total number of max. 10 competing athletes per nation. No more than 4 athletes of the same sex may be registered within each category. The organizing nation is entitled to a double quota, that is max. 20 competing athletes.

Under regular circumstances, the max. number of competing athletes must not exceed 140 (ICR 1280.3). Pursuant to ICR 1270.3, the organizing nation may register more than the double quota of participants.

For the team evaluation, only the team declared at the first Team Captains meeting as "A" will be considered.

All competitors must be registered with the National ski associations, have insurance coverage and a signed permission from their parents. The technical delegate of the FIS inspects all the required documents.

5. COMPETITION PROCEDURE

The competition is aimed at individual and team placement. In team placement the sums of all the points are calculated according to the procedures of the old principle for the World Cup.

In the case of an equal number of points, the country with a higher point placement is the winner.

6. PRIZES

ZAGREB CHILDREN FIS TROPHY: awarded to the best Team

Gold medal: first place in each discipline and category
Silver medal: second place in each discipline and category
Bronze medal: third place in each discipline and category

7. ALLOTMENT INTO GROUPS AND START ORDER

(FIS Instruction Leaflet, November 23rd, 2003.)

The start order in the groups is made by the Jury. In each group each participating nation is allotted one starting place max.

If more than 15 nations have registered, the following principles apply:

Group 1:

The first group will contain one athlete from each nation registered. Each nation is allotted only one start place.

Group 2 - 3 - 4: Same as group 1.

Group 5:

In this group are competitors from the host nation (B team)

Group 6 - 7 - 8 - ... :

The last group consists of the athletes of the organizing nation in double quota. If the number of competing athletes exceeds the double quota, a separate group will be drawn after the entire starting field in the same procedure as group 1.

The team leaders are responsible for the identification of participants in each group.

Each group is drawn separately.

The starting order for the second run is determined by the result list of the first run except for the first 30 competitors who will start in reverse order of their placement in the first run.

8. THE COMPETITION

The competition follows the international ski competition rules, with a FIS Technical Delegate present during the Event. The competitors compete at their own risk and/or at the risk of those who send them. The Organizers decline any responsibility in case of injury to the participants or a third part.



9. EXPENSES

The national representatives (1st National Team) are guests of the Organizing Committee as follows: for a complete team: 1 teamleader + 3 companions; for less than 10 competitors: 1 teamleader + 2 companions; for teams with less than 5 competitors: 1 teamleader + 1 companion.

2nd and eventually 3rd National Team are not guests of the Organizing Committee and they defray costs themselves.

The hospitality includes: halfboard from 21st March (dinner) to 23rd March (breakfast) 2010. in a hotel and a ski-pass for free use of all the ski-lifts. Every Federation must take over the expenses for travel, transfer from airport to the hotel included.

6 – 9 competitors	1 teamleader + 2 companions
3 – 5 competitors	1 teamleader + 1 companions
1 – 2 competitors	1 teamleader
